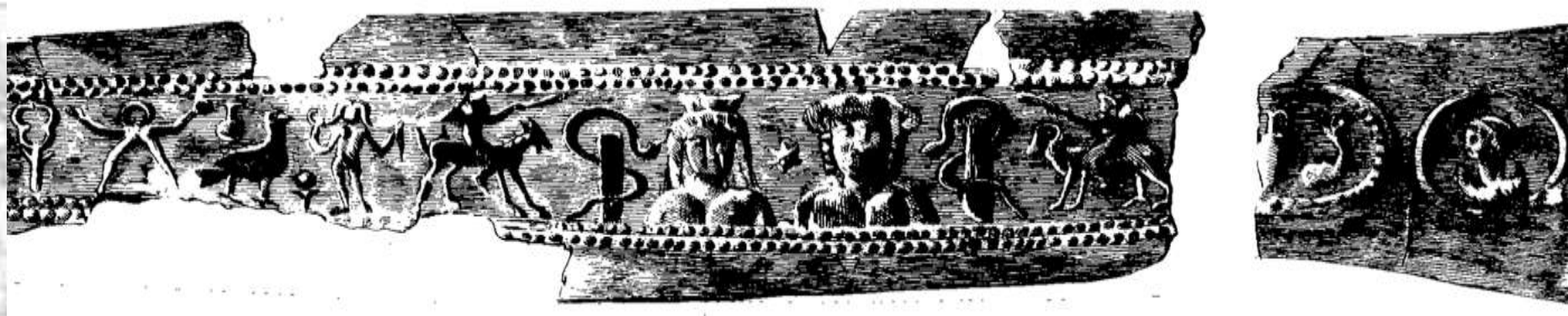

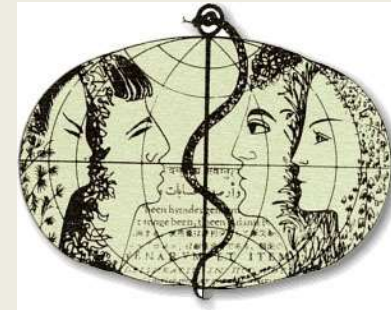

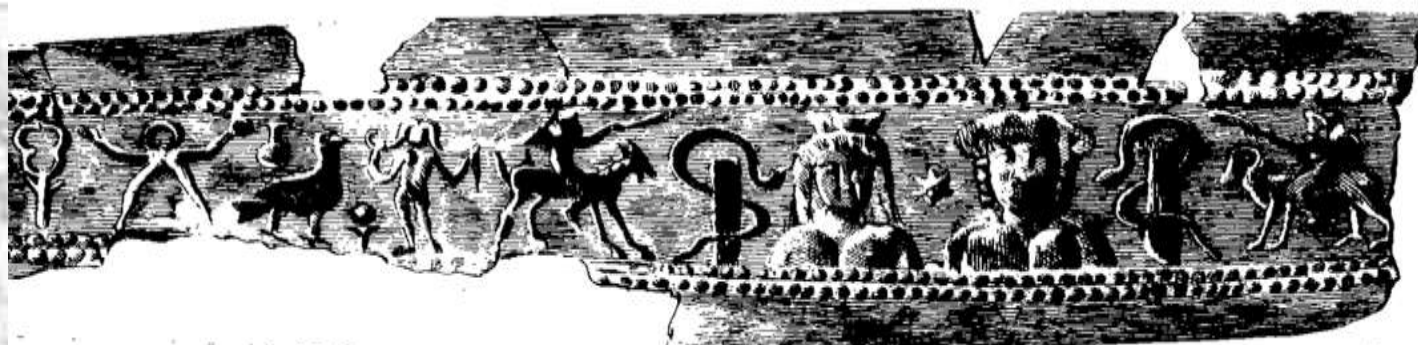

The International Society for the History of Medicine has chosen Tunis to hold the 50th edition of its congress, on the theme "Medicine and Mediterranean peoples" under the sign of Tanit, brandishing the caduceus of peace, with a background image of the Sea Peoples from a bas-relief in Medinet Habu, Egypt, depicting their battle against Ramses III in 1143 BC. The history of the transmission of medicine in the Mediterranean begins there, with a war between the Sea Peoples and the Nile people.
